

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

Government College of Engineering & Technology, Jammu
(An Autonomous Institution under the Government of Jammu & Kashmir)

AND

Kaynes Technology
Parwanoo, District Solan (Himachal Pradesh)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU") is made and entered into on this 30 day of January 2026,

BY AND BETWEEN

Government College of Engineering & Technology, Jammu (GCET Jammu), having its campus at Chak Bhalwal, Jammu (J&K), hereinafter referred to as the "**First Party**", represented through its **Principal/Director**, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns;

AND

Kaynes Technology, having its manufacturing unit at Parwanoo, District Solan (H.P.), hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**", represented through its **Director (HR) / Authorized Signatory**, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns.

The First Party and the Second Party are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "**Parties**" and individually as a "**Party**."

WHEREAS

A. The First Party is a premier technical educational institution engaged in imparting undergraduate and postgraduate education in engineering and technology.

B. The Second Party is a reputed industry organization engaged in advanced manufacturing and technology-driven solutions, including areas relevant to electronics, semiconductor ecosystem, automation, and allied domains.

C. Both Parties recognize the importance of collaboration between academia and industry for skill development, employability enhancement, and exposure to emerging technologies.

D. Both Parties desire to establish a mutually beneficial cooperation in the areas of internships, industrial training, placements, expert lectures, industrial visits, and skill development activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

CLAUSE 1: OBJECTIVE OF COLLABORATION

The objective of this MoU is to promote **Industry–Institution Interaction** and to facilitate cooperation in skill-based education, training, and exposure to industrial practices, particularly in emerging and advanced technology areas.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1 Industrial Training & Internships

The Second Party shall provide opportunities for **industrial training, internships, and live exposure** to the students of the First Party, subject to availability and internal policies of the Second Party.

The Second Party may also register internship opportunities on the **AICTE Internship Portal** for the benefit of students.

2.2 Industrial Visits

The Second Party shall, as feasible, permit **faculty members and students** of the First Party to visit its manufacturing units or facilities to gain insight into industrial processes and practices.

2.3 Expert / Guest Lectures

The Second Party shall extend support by facilitating **expert lectures, invited talks, and technical interactions** for students and faculty of the First Party on contemporary industry trends, skill requirements, and technological advancements.

2.4 Placement Support

The Second Party may consider **trained and eligible students** of the First Party for placement opportunities, as per the recruitment norms and requirements of the Second Party. This MoU does not guarantee placement.

2.5 Skill Development & Collaborative Activities

Both Parties may jointly organize **workshops, seminars, training programs, and skill development initiatives**, as mutually agreed upon from time to time.

2.6 Financial Commitment

This MoU does not involve any **financial commitment** on the part of the First Party. Any financial implications, if required for specific programs, shall be decided separately through written mutual consent.

CLAUSE 3: IMPLEMENTATION & COORDINATION

Each Party shall nominate a **Coordinator** to oversee and facilitate activities under this MoU and to ensure smooth coordination between the Parties.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY AND TERMINATION

4.1 This MoU shall be valid for a period of **two (02) years** from the date of signing.

4.2 Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving **three (03) months' written notice** to the other Party, without assigning any reason.

4.3 Activities already in progress at the time of termination shall be allowed to conclude, unless otherwise mutually decided.


CLAUSE 5: LEGAL STATUS

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating a **partnership, joint venture, or employer-employee relationship** between the Parties. Both Parties shall function as independent entities.

CLAUSE 6: AMENDMENTS

Any amendment or modification to this MoU shall be made **in writing** and signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

CLAUSE 7: JURISDICTION
